President's Message

As most of you are aware by now, the developer Burgess and Niple has submitted plans to the county to develop the plot of land behind Admiral Drive. We thought that we had convinced them that this piece of land was too expensive to develop last year. However, they seem to have new ideas. We are confident that they will not access this land via Lighthouse Lane, as was their plan last year. This year, they are seeking to get the State to allow them access from Gordon Blvd (Route 123). Permission to do this has previously been rejected on grounds of the amount of traffic congestion that already exists at the intersection of Gordon and Old Bridge Road. They seem to be flexing their economic and political muscle to try and change the State's mind.

We have been in close contact with Mike May, the new Occoquan Supervisor, and we have been in discussions with the Chair of the County Board, Corey Stewart who happens to be the former Occoquan Supervisor. We have also been in discussions with our lawyers and environmental activists. All of these folks have been working with County transportation and environmental staff on our behalf. According to what has happened in the past, the County and State transportation people could very well grant access to Gordon Blvd from the property behind Admiral due to the fact that there has been no public outcry about this issue. Please tell everyone you know to call the people listed below and tell them what you think about development at the corner of Gordon Blvd and Old Bridge Road -- Helen Cuervo (703-366-1931) and Brad Johnson (703-792-6860).

With grassroots pressure, I feel confident that we will once again demonstrate the negative environmental impact of development on this site. The members of this community will be kept appraised of issues as they develop. If you have any questions on this issue, please feel free to contact any member of the Board.

On another issue, I implore all members of the community to read the Home Owners Association documents. Over the last several years we have had a growing number of people who do not follow the rules laid out in the Covenants, By-Laws and Guidelines. This is particularly true of trash placement and changes to the exterior of your property. These two issues will be closely monitored as we move into spring.

In reaction to the trash violations, those who disobey the trash guidelines will be fined <u>\$50 per violation</u>, to be assessed on the quarterly dues statement.

The Board is beginning discussions of how to approach changes to the exterior of homes that have not been approved by the Board. If you have made changes to the exterior of your home and do not have written approval from the Board for such action, you should attend the next meeting. We want input from all parties.

If you plan on attending the next meeting, which is Monday, March 12, starting at 8 PM, please contact me so that we can have sufficient space set aside.


